Mothers' Union in Coventry Diocese celebrates 100 years this year, and as some of you will have seen, there was an exhibition at the cathedral during the Thy Kingdom Come service. As many members will not have had the chance to see it, I hope there will be other opportunities to display it around the Diocese. One such will be at St John's in Kenilworth around the weekend of 3rd-4th August. St John's will be holding a Mary Sumner Day Eucharist on 4th August at 6.00 to which everyone is very warmly invited, and we will serve tea in the hall beforehand to give people a chance to see the exhibition. It would be lovely if branches and groups of members could come and see it at St John's, whether or not they are coming to the service, and it could go to other areas of the Diocese too.



If you would like to host the exhibition, there are some important points to note
